the making of visual news sets out to show how photography has changed the way we read report and sell the news it investigates how photographs first became news images at the end of the nineteenth century and how magazines in the usa the uk france and germany have put them to use ever since drawing on a wide selection of images author thierry gervais in collaboration with gaëlle morel analyses news photographs in the context of their original presentation in print highly illustrated
