luther jones is an african american man living in selma al he is an older man who has lived through a lot of life in the wake of the 50th anniversary of the march on selma he reflects on his participation on that day fifty years earlier from singing in church to saying goodbye to his mother luther recounts the activities that he believes shaped his life events that made him want to create a better life for his children even if it met risking his life to do it he walks hand in hand with the other thousands of men and women that day hoping for equality as he sifts through his memories of this day we see a man that has risked his life for the greater good and lost a lot of himself along the way but no matter the price that was paid he is determined to make the march again visit the trail where his life was forever changed and grab hands for his walk to remember

on april 15 1941 sarajevo fell to germany s 16th motorized infantry division the city

along with the rest of bosnia was incorporated into the independent state of croatia one of the most brutal of nazi satellite states run by the ultranationalist croat ustasha regime the occupation posed an extraordinary set of challenges to sarajevo s famously cosmopolitan culture and its civic consciousness these challenges included humanitarian and political crises and tensions of national identity as detailed for the first time in emily greble s book the city s complex mosaic of confessions catholic orthodox muslim jewish and ethnicities croat serb jew bosnian muslim roma and various other national minorities began to fracture under the ustasha regime s violent assault on serbs jews and roma contested categories of identity in this multiconfessional space tearing at the city s most basic traditions nor was there unanimity within the various ethnic and confessional groups some catholic croats detested the ustasha regime while others rode to power within it muslims guarreled about how best to position themselves for the postwar world and some cast their lot with hitler and joined the ill fated muslim waffen ss in time these centripetal forces were complicated by the yugoslav civil war a multisided civil conflict fought among communist partisans chetniks serb nationalists ustashas and a host of other smaller groups the absence of military conflict in sarajevo allows greble to explore the different sides of civil conflict shedding light on the ways that humanitarian crises contributed to civil tensions and the ways that marginalized groups sought political power within the shifting political system there is much drama in these pages in the late days of the war the ustasha leaders realizing that their game was up turned the city into a slaughterhouse before fleeing abroad the arrival of the communist partisans in april 1945 ushered in a new revolutionary era one met with caution by the townspeople greble tells this complex story with remarkable clarity throughout she emphasizes the measures that the city's leaders took to preserve against staggering odds the cultural and religious pluralism that had long enabled the city s diverse populations to thrive together

no one knew the mississippi delta more intimately or told its story more eloquently than did david I cohn 1894 1960 between 1935 and 1960 he produced ten books including his best known god shakes creation later expanded into where i was born and raised and scores of articles and essays including more than sixty such pieces in the atlantic monthly alone one of his greatest frustrations however was not finding time to organize and prepare for publication the memoir he began in 1953 james c cobb discovered cohn s memoir in 1985 in the david I cohn collection at the university of mississippi struck by its richness and convinced that it should be published he undertook the task of arranging and editing the material what cobb has brought forth is an immensely valuableand entertaining work of both literary and historical significance that plots one extraordinary man s course through the changes of the twentieth century cohn was in essence a cosmopolitan provincial an observer who realized that the problems and circumstances of the delta were at the same time unique and universal a native of greenville he was educated at the university of virginia and yale university law school a brief but highly successful career in business allowed him to pursue his dream of being a writer he traveled widely but remained faithful to his delta roots counting among his close friends both william alexander percy and hodding carter he was intensely interested in politics and served as speechwriter for democratic party leaders including adlai stevenson george mcgovern and lyndon johnson lamenting the trend toward overspecialization cohn did not shrink from expressing his views on a wide array of topics race and religion free trade and internationalism technology and culture and materialism and matrimony among others southern to the marrow and an almost zealously patriotic american he was also a jew and he managed a harmonious integration of all three identities rather than the separation or suppression of any one in his introduction cohn describes his memoir as primarily an evocation of persons and places the physical and spiritual terrain of my youth a period that takes him from birth through approximately 1934 cobb picks up the thread in a concluding essay surveying cohn's later life and analyzing his literary career in light of his southern origins racial views ethnic ties and internationalist perspective perhaps better than any other single work by cohn the mississippi delta and the world reveals that he was a truly learned commentator on the human condition one who benefited enormously both from his travels and from his determination to maintain his ties to the place where he was born and raised
