this is the never before published extended version of wolfe s short story in memory of his father the four lost men is the first publication of the long version of wolfe s story of familial and national reflection set during world war i wolfe supplies a moving portrait of his dying father as well as a rich mediation on american history and ambitions on the verge of america s entry into a broadening global conflict discussion of the title characters presidents garfield arthur harrison and hayes provides opportunity for assessment of the mood and promise of the nation as well as reflection on the obstacles that had obscured paths

toward untapped american potential garfield arthur harrison and hayes the four republican presidents who followed grant during the reconstruction and post reconstruction eras were all civil war generals and self made men though none experienced a particularly distinguished term in office these presidents are iconic figures in the stories and political musings of the narrator s dying father in his efforts to understand their importance to his father the teenaged narrator comes to appreciate the act of storytelling that redefines these men in his father s memory and in turn redefines his father in the his own memory originally published as a short story of 7 000 words in scribner s magazine in 1934 and later abridged by 1 000 words for reissue in the 1935 anthology from death to morning wolfe s expanded tale is published here for the first time in its intended form and full length of some 21 000 words editors arlyn and matthew j bruccoli have employed the same methods to reestablish this text as they used to wide acclaim in their centennial edition of o lost the story of a buried life the unabridged version of wolfe s look homeward angel the reestablishment of the long version of four lost men opens an undeveloped area of scholarship into wolfe s short fiction and serves as a model for restoring other such works

a story seemingly drawn out of a hollywood action script gripping stuff canada s history just before midnight on february 13 1950 three engines of a us air force b 36 intercontinental bomber caught fire over canada s northwest coast the crew jumped and the plane ditched somewhere in the pacific ocean almost four years later the wreck of the bomber was found accidentally in a remote location in the coastal mountains of british columbia three hours flying time in the opposite direction of where it was supposed to have crashed after years of silence the united states finally admitted to losing its very first nuclear bomb the incident was its first broken arrow the code name for accidents involving nuclear weapons but was the bomb dropped and exploded over the inside passage or was it blown up at the aircraft s resting place in the mountains this cold war era tale follows the last flight of bomber 075 and attempts to unravel the real story behind more than fifty years of secrecy misdirection and misinformation

palestinian soldiers the lrdg perfected the art of irregular mechanized warfare conducted in the rear of the enemy's forces in the desert attacking enemy installations of all kinds mining roads raiding airfields destroying enemy aircraft on the ground and inflicting losses upon the enemy in inverse proportion to their own remarkably low rate of casualties through meticulous research in original archival material this book thus tells the extraordinary story of how a relatively small number of dedicated men developed the methods and techniques for crossing by motor vehicle the depths of the then unmapped and seemingly impassable great deserts of egypt and libya the western desert during the british army's north african campaign of 1940-43 the long range desert group and the special air service as a matter of course did extraordinary things the heroic was the commonplace their tactics techniques and remarkable success in desert warfare continue to make them of great interest to the student of military affairs likewise as it seeks to answer how the deep desert can best be used for military purposes this study is pertinent to today's military operations perhaps more so than at any time since world war ii this study provides fresh insights into the nature of desert warfare past present and future and reveals the peculiarities of this warfare often lost to modern armies a virtual primer useful to commanders and soldiers alike at long last this book can find its rightful place in the classroom of military courses and colleges and in the hands of those interested in the intricacies complexities and problems of military operations in desert regions from the foreword to the book by colonel retired david m glantz

my belief in this war is as deep as any faith can be one of the most personal compelling and enduring accounts of life as an american civil war battlefield commander is in these pages wounded five times and promoted to general in january 1865 rutherford b hayes would later become the 19th president of the united states in a diary and in letters hayes recounts in great detail major battles his men technology of arms and the southern countryside and people with wit and affection he writes to his beloved wife lucy and his children mother and uncle his father died before his birth and friends sergeant ritter had a bullet shot into his head lodging between the scalp and skull he fell but instantly jumped up saying you must shoot lower if you want to kill me of hayes ulyssees s grant wrote his conduct on the field was marked by conspicuous gallantry as well as the display of qualities of a higher order than that of mere personal daring when

approached by one of his men for permission to marry hayes tells us i asked him why he was in a hurry to marry if he knew much about her and what was her name he replied i like her looks and after confessing that he didn t know her name that he thought it was eliza watson he admitted that the thing was this eight hundred dollars had been left to him payable on his marriage and he wanted the money out at interest at times he becomes introspective and philosophical queer world we fret our little hour are happy and pass away away where to this longing after immortality at other times he talks of good times and the friendships among officers and men well what good times we have had wit anecdote song feast wine and good fellowship gentlemen and scholars unlike many of the wonderful accounts by everyday foot soldiers this perspective by an educated commander and future president provides you with a tale that is both broad and personal every memoir of the american civil war provides us with another view of the catastrophe that changed the country forever for the first time this long out of print volume is available as an affordable well formatted book for e readers and smartphones be sure to look inside by clicking the cover above or download a sample
