to save anyone from reading it through we here state briefly the thesis we who have received the sacrament of orders call ourselves priests the author does not recall any priest ever having said i was ordained a victim nor did he ever say i am studying to be a victim that seemed almost alien to being a priest the seminary always told us to be good priests never were we told to be willing victims and yet was not christ the priest a victim did he not come to die he did not offer a lamb a bullock or doves he never offered anything except himself he gave himself up on our behalf a sacrifice breathing out fragrance as he offered it to god ephesians 5 2 pagan priests old testament priests medicine men all offered a sacrifice apart from themselves but not our lord he was sacerdos victima this being so just as we miss much in the life of christ by not showing that the shadow of the cross cast itself even over the crib and the carpenter shop as well as over his public life so we have a mutilated concept of our priesthood if we envisage it apart from making ourselves victims in the prolongation of his incarnation there is nothing else in this book but that idea and if the reader would like to hear that chord struck a hundred times he may now proceed
