for more than twenty years charles templeton was a major figure in the church in canada and the united states during the 1950s he and billy graham were the two most successful exponents of mass evangelism in north america templeton spoke nightly to stadium crowds of up to thirty thousand people however increasing doubts about the validity of the old testament and the teachings of the christian church finally brought about a crisis in his faith and in 1957 he resigned from the ministry in farewell to god templeton speaks out about his reasons for the abandonment of his faith in straightforward language templeton deals with such subjects as the creation fable racial prejudice in the bible the identity of jesus of nazareth jesus alienation from his family the second class status of women in the church the mystery of evil the illusion that prayer works why there is suffering and death and the loss of faith in god he concludes with a positive personal statement i believe

the hijacked mind com the evangelist who abandoned jesus and billy graham don t ever become an apostate charles templeton was a canadian evangelist journalist author and broadcaster whose life took a dramatic turn from devout christian preacher to outspoken agnostic and critic of religion early life and evangelical career born october 7 1915 in toronto ontario canada early career started as a cartoonist and journalist for the toronto globe and toronto star evangelical rise became a prominent christian evangelist in the 1940s and 1950s often preaching alongside billy graham he was considered one of the most promising young evangelists of his time crisis of faith and departure from christianity theological doubts templeton began to struggle with doubts about the literal truth of the bible particularly the genesis creation story education attended princeton theological seminary to explore his questions more deeply break with evangelism eventually declared himself an agnostic and left the ministry which led to a public and painful split with billy graham later life and legacy author and broadcaster transitioned into a successful career in media becoming a radio and television host newspaper editor and author notable work his most famous book farewell to god 1996 details his journey from faith to doubt and critiques organized religion death passed away on june 7 2001 in toronto at the age of 85 templeton s story is often cited in discussions about faith doubt and the complexities of belief his intellectual honesty and willingness to confront difficult questions left a lasting impact on both religious and secular audiences the dr apostasy

the history of religious change has been largely devoted to study of the churches revivalists focuses on evangelists singling out several significant entrepreneurs hugh crossley and john hunter active from 1880 to

1910 oswald j smith who built his independent toronto church into a popular evangelistic emporium frank buchman and the oxford group who appealed to the upper classes in the 1930s and charles templeton who enjoyed two careers as a revivalist kee shows that by adjusting their methods to the cultural forms of the day these evangelists contributed to the vitality of canadian protestantism
