across the country are hundreds of high school football rivalries each might lay claim that it is special in many ways in the heart of the great central valley of california is one such rivalry that is exceptional in its power over the people who have been part of it two high schools redwood and mt whitney began playing an annual football game against each other in 1955 the 50th game of this traditional rivalry was played in 2004 before 10 000 fans and a live television audience the two schools located only a few blocks from each other in visalia california a city of 100 000 people have maintained this intense rivalry for over 50 years like very few schools have ever done the game is played before a packed stadium every year and the community claims it as the biggest event during the entire year part 1 explores the
